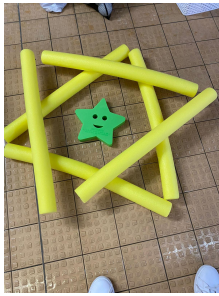


## Christmas Activities and End of Winter Term

### Children's Academy Lessons

The last lessons at the end of term in December should involve some festive activities, and as marked on each venue sheet, this should be coordinated with the other teachers working at the venue for that session to ensure all children are involved in activities and to ensure some classes are not left out. This is not however a full half an hour of free swimming - parents are still paying for the lesson - and so activities should be limited to half of the lesson and involve some swimming elements!

- Woggle skills - tie into knots to become reindeer antlers, make a circle with the woggle and pretend to be Santa jumping down the chimney from poolside, seahorses can become reindeers, all hold onto each others reindeer to make a Santa sleigh
- Mushroom float or tuck jumps = Christmas Bauble, star floats or star jumps = snowflakes
- Collect floats and make a Christmas tree shape out of them
- Christmas ducks and toys to be used in lessons



### Adult Academy Lessons

### Splash Academy Lessons

Lessons can include winter and Christmas themes. This can be developed into a range of skills and activities which also provide swimming and water confidence skills.
